- Formed because of increased development and little voice from the community
- East and West of I-5 concerns: lack of playgrounds, lack of public space
- ALUV part of boundaries

  - Working with established groups
  - Focus on livability - residents, attractiveness

- NSF Grant - need 3 grants to raise funds - haven't been submitted yet
  - When grants awarded, the funds have to be awarded within 3 months
  - 50% of funds must be in donations of time and dollars
- OED Grant - Lots going on
  - Contracts and agreements executed.
  - Planning on 3 business meetings: July, August, September - several options
  - Once days are decided, we will do a mailing to all of the businesses in the urban village.

- Work with Epic Life on clean-up Aurora event on July 8 mainly the northend of the ALUV business district.
- Grant commits to 2 socials: primarily for businesses to get together and meet one another. Possibly partner with Epic Life NORA type event and one at The Lantern.
- ALUV Design Guidelines - edit and format still to be done
- May 24, 2018 CAC meeting - still working to access contracts/metrics
- May 31, 2018 - report on meeting with CM Mosqueda and Gonzalez
  - Civil and listening, No major disruptions
- D5 CM at large tour - evolving
  - Tours on July 27 and 31 - 10:30 -12:00 PM
  - 1 and ½ hour routes, 2-15 minutes to present, people presenting at stops
  - Docent on trip to give commentary; rotating docent who knows the area.
  - One docent for each area.
