- III. <u>Guest Speaker(s)</u> Geoff Wentlandt, Senior Planning Manager with Office of Planning and Community Development (OPCD)
  - MHA update
    - o Decision in October 2018
    - SEPA must be resolved first probably will go into next year
    - o Can't vote on it until 2019 can move forward after hearing examiner's decision
    - See handout summary
  - Interim Controls Moratorium
    - o Runs out in October 2018
    - Renewal process easily done no public hearing needed council just votes.
    - Probably before budget
  - Neighborhood Design Guidelines
    - Draft given to Geoff only constraint is when it will be completed but will work with ALUV on this
    - Procedure
      - Has to be adopted by ordinance
      - There would need to be public engagement
      - Open House with Inspection, OPCD and DON departments
    - SEPA review environmental checklist
      - Probably 3-4 months most of the work has been done
    - What does ALUV need to do to get it going? Grant
  - 2019 OPCD work problem
    - Many groups have design guidelines just need updating
    - Who gets assigned to work on this? Individual? Point of contact?
    - O How do you work with SDOT on planning?
      - Different levels coordinated with comprehensive plan
        - Sidewalks, crossings, bike lanes
      - SDOT has nixed other improvements to Aurora unplanted medians, repair holes in sidewalks
  - Information on C1, C2 lands zoning study
    - o 130th and 140th
    - o Crown Hill
    - Downtown City Center by tunnel
    - o ALUV next tier mid 2019-2020 somewhere

- What's the criteria?
  - Demographics have flipped since 2010 2015 very different
  - ALUV high on displacement list
  - SPS report ESL, people of color doesn't correspond with actual numbers when compared to the comprehensive plan.
- No major changes to transit on Aurora some supplement
- Citywide review of C1 Commercial zones. Review the value. Are they still working?
  - Economic outreach; public meetings in the fall; input into this study.
  - ALUV wouldn't be impacted but areas N and S of urban village would be.
- What incentives can be created for Aurora to entice the development with a rezone? (To help neutralize the MHA fee - something to spark development.)
  - What can we do to offset fees to make this area more attractive for development?
    - Tough to make an exception for ALUV
    - Already, in the lowest fee area
    - Can't the fees be offset by adding green spaces, meeting space?
    - City wants to support NC, but there will be pushback.
