Key Points

The North Precinct has four important components to officer performance and safety, community involvement and precinct operations:

- 1. Precinct and Parking Garage
- 2. Public amenity spaces
- 3. Training center
- 4. Firearms Training Area

The North Precinct is an expensive building, but not the most expensive facility we surveyed. The intention of this similar facilities analysis is to show that there is wide range of costs for public safety facilities and that the North Precinct is within that range.

Methodology

This analysis includes recent Seattle public safety buildings, buildings mentioned in the Brier Dudley Seattle Times Article and other facilities recommended as similar by the design team.

Attempt to adjust for:

- Size of facility;
- **Type** of programmatic functions included;
- **Inflation** due to time of construction. Some of the facilities mentioned were built over 10 years ago. Inflation, particularly in the construction industry, and even more so in Seattle, is very real.
- **Construction Cost Versus Total Budget** Compare facilities' entire budgeted costs to the North Precinct entire budget, including land acquisition.
- It is difficult to get an absolute apples to apples comparison due to differences in budgeting, scope
 of project, location, lack of detailed budget break-down, etc. Therefore, some context is provided
 for each facility to explain key components, as well as gaps in information.

Inflation Indices

- For construction amounts, costs were escalated according to a National Construction Index developed by Turner Construction.
- For non-construction amounts (staff time, art costs, etc.), costs were escalated according to national CPI.
